Festival Tour #4 (7 nights/9 days)

Day 1 Monday, June 8, 2020

Depart via scheduled air service to Vienna, Austria

Day 2 Tuesday, June 9 Vienna (D)

Arrive in

Meet your MCI Tour Manager, who will assist the group to awaiting chartered motorcoach

Enjoy a visit to the Vienna City Cemetery to visit the graves of Beethoven, Strauss, Brahms, Schubert and the Mozart Memorial

Take an orientation tour of Vienna upon arrival

Late afternoon hotel check-in

Evening Welcome Dinner included, and overnight

Vienna is still considered the music capital of the world. It is a city of refined tastes, grace, style and unmatched artistic accomplishments. For a thousand years, Vienna was the capital of the far-flung Holy Roman and Hapsburg empires. Though its people and ways have changed, Vienna has retained its imperial monuments, not as reminders of past glories, but as living symbols of its present freedom

Day 3 Wednesday, June 10 Vienna (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel

Half-day guided tour of *Historical Vienna* includes the Ringstraße, Imperial Palace, State Opera, Town Hall, Burgkapelle (home of the Vienna Boys Choir), Palace Stables, Strauß Monument, and entrance to Schönbrunn Palace, built by the Hapsburgs in imitation of Versailles

Day 4 Thursday, June 11 Vienna (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel

Morning Rehearsal*

Half-day guided tour of *Musical Vienna* includes entrance to the Haus der Musik (House of Music), a modern interactive sound museum located in the historic city center. This tour also includes the Museum of the Vienna Philharmonic, which is part of the House of Music

Day 5 Friday, June 12 Vienna (B,D)

Morning visit to the Kahlenberg located in the Vienna Woods to see the Beethoven trail. Also visit (entrance included) to the Beethoven Heiligenstadt apartment

*Evening Beethoven Choral Festival Concert in St. Stephen's Cathedral**

Evening dinner included, and overnight

Day 6 Saturday, June 13 Melk / Mondsee / Salzburg (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out
Morning transfer to Salzburg via Melk and Mondsee
Stop in Melk to visit the world-famous Abbey. The Abbey of Melk which crowns a rocky bluff overlooking the Danube more than 150 ft. above the river, is the apogee of Baroque architecture in Austria
Lunch, on own
Afternoon visit to Mondsee to visit St. Michael's Church (site of *The Sound of Music* wedding)
Continue on to Salzburg
Evening dinner included, and overnight

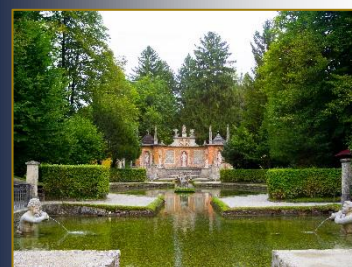
Salzburg, Mozart's birthplace, is a delight from the first sight of the outline of the Hohensalzburg Fortress, the symbol of the power of the prince-archbishops. The city's picturesque streets with their wrought-iron signs, its spacious squares with sculptured fountains and the noble architecture of its buildings inspired by bishops with a passion for construction, leave memories which linger for years

Day 7 Sunday, June 14 Salzburg (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel
Enjoy a guided tour of Salzburg including Mirabell Palace and Gardens, Mozart Square, the Dom (cathedral), University Church, entrance to the Mozarthaus (Mozart's birthplace) and a cable car ride up to the Fortress (for an unparalleled view of the city below)
Lunch, on own
Afternoon time at leisure for shopping and sightseeing
*Performance in Salzburg as part of the American Celebration of Music in Austria**
Evening dinner included, and overnight

Day 8 Monday, June 15 Salzburg/Neuschwanstein/Munich (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out
Morning tour of Salzburg. Sightseeing today will include driving past Schloß Leopoldskron, featured in "The Sound of Music", and entrance to Schloß Hellbrunn with its famous "Sound of Music" gazebo and trick fountains
Lunch, on own
Transfer to Munich via Neuschwanstein Castle
Tour through the Bavarian Alps includes Neuschwanstein Castle (made famous by the Walt Disney model in Anaheim), built by the infamous Ludwig II (including entrance and uphill transport). Also visit the



charming Wieskirche (Church in the Meadow) and Oberammergau, the site of the world famous Passion Play which is performed every 10 years
Continue on to Munich
Evening Farewell Dinner included, and overnight

Munich is ideally located in southern Germany near the Alps. It is a first-class cultural center and is a flourishing economic zone. Munich's cultural wealth, its special atmosphere - a blend of gaiety, tolerance and respect for tradition - and the beauty of the surrounding countryside have combined to make it one of the most appreciated of German cities

Day 9 Tuesday, June 16 Depart for home (B)

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out
Transfer to the Munich Airport for return flight home
